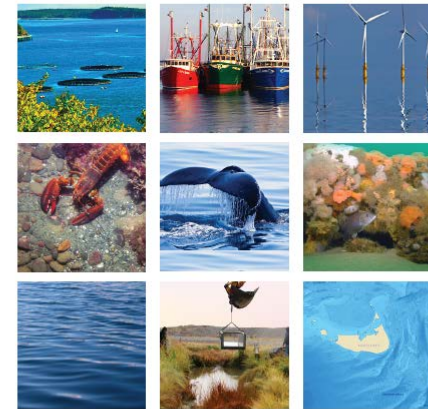

# Work Program Area 1: Data Catalog Tasks
