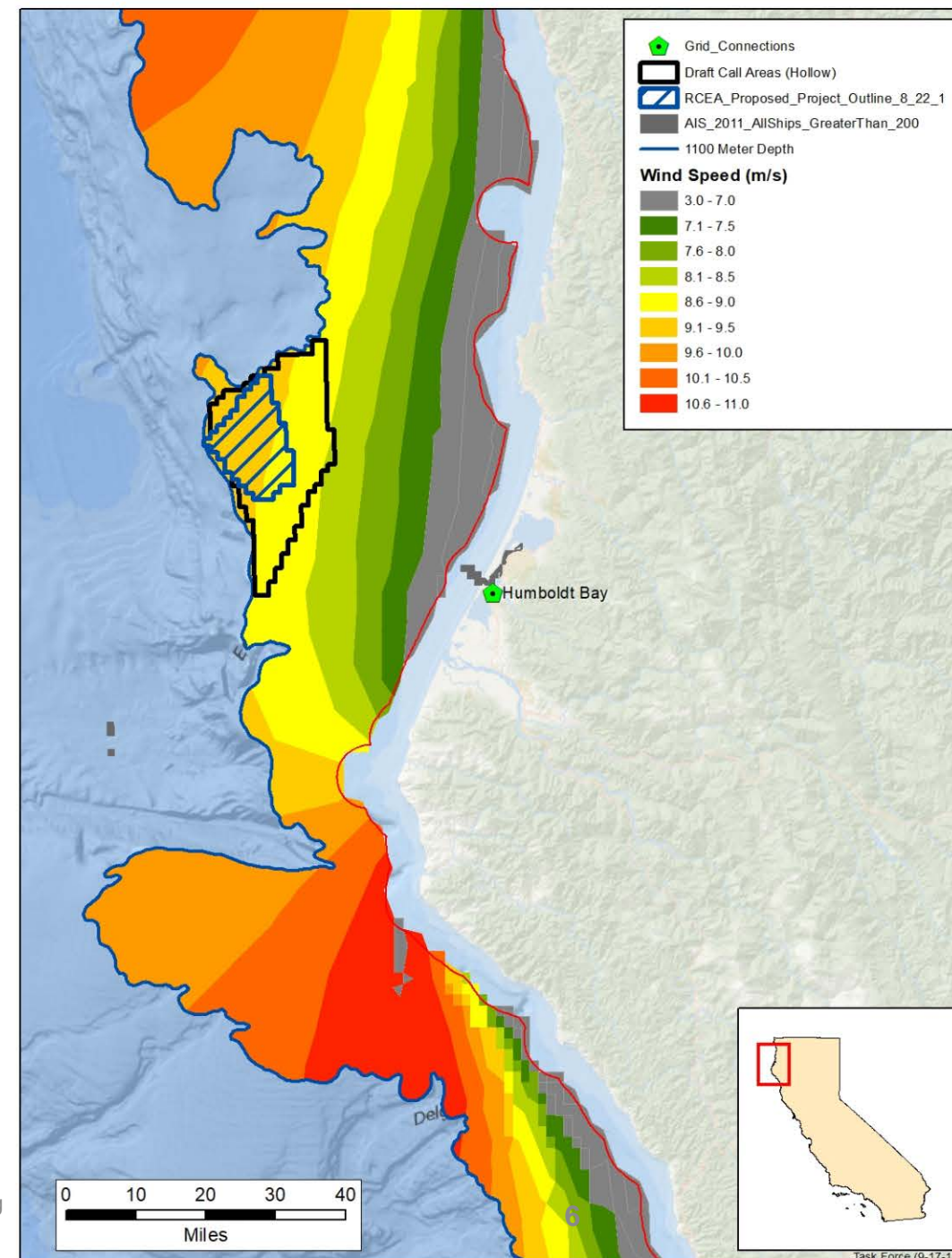

# WCODP Funding Proposals for 2018



## Basic Operation and Maintenance (Annual)

Web hosting is the single most important operations cost that ensures “the lights stay on” for the WCODP.

Includes

- WCODP infrastructure,
- West Coast Marine Debris Database and
- Climate Change Funding Catalog.

Web Hosting Servers: \$13K  
Software Updates and Server Maintenance: \$7K



## Coordination and Outreach (Annual)

The Coordinator conducts outreach, administers the WCODP, manages grant deliverables, and strengthens partnerships. Organizes Portal Coordination Team, Portal Development Team, and WCODN.

WCODP Project Coordinator:  
.5FTE = \$40, 1FTE = \$80K  
Annual Network Meeting (travel and accommodations): \$15K



## Use Case Expansion and Development

The “use case” approach has proved to be a highly successful technology development method that involves users at the very beginning of the process to understand needs for data and tools.

Ex) Marine Debris Data Viewer Use Case.

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# WCODP Funding Picture in 2018

- Moore Foundation Grant (2018):
  - \$75k for Task 1: Partnership of data and science experts to support regional ocean activities; Technical Consultant to support ODP.
  - \$40k for : 0.5 FTE to be contracted to support ongoing administration of West Coast Ocean Data Portal
- Moore Foundation Grant (2019):
  - \$40k for Task 1: Partnership of data and science experts to support regional ocean activities; Technical Consultant to support ODP.
  - \$20k for : 0.5 FTE to be contracted to support ongoing administration of West Coast Ocean Data Portal

# WCODP Funding Picture in 2018

- BOEM Grant (2018):
  - \$100k - Operations, Maintenance, and Administration for West Coast Ocean Data Portal for the Pacific Region
  - ~~Develop Scope of Work for funding allocation~~
  - Work with BOEM and SSCWRP to arrange funding agreements (in progress)
  - Develop RFP for a WCODP Coordinator at .5 FTE
  - Prioritize list of system enhancements

# Work Program Overview

- WCOA – Regional needs?
  - Re-organize front end of the WCODP for supporting the work of the WCOA
    - Regional search facets, thematically grouped data resources, regional data products
  - Sub-regional Tasks:
    - WA: Connections to WA agency source providers made, and records from their databases harvested by the WCODP
    - OR/N. CA – Spatial Coordination Framework
